- A founding editor of the journal *Applied Developmental Science*, Dr. Fisher is author of *Decoding the Ethics Code: A Practical Guide for Psychologists*, co-editor of 8 books and author of over 100 theoretical and empirical publications in the areas of ethics in medical and social science research and practice and life span development.
- Her federally funded research programs focus on ethical issues and wellbeing of vulnerable populations including ethnic minority youth and families, active drug users, medically ill youth, college students at risk for drinking problems, and adults with impaired consent capacity.
