## NYS DOH Anonymous HIV Counseling and Testing Program

*Anonymous HIV testing means that you do not have to provide names to obtain HIV tests. Each patient is given a code number that is used to keep track of his test record. Written on a return appointment card, this number enables patients to receive their test results.
